

Statement from Sheriff Rambosk provided by Chief Stephanie Spell, Collier County Sheriff's Office on July 14, 2021

“The oath of office that I solemnly swear to commits me to uphold the US Constitution and the Florida Constitution and to protect the constitutional guarantees of all persons. I’m honored to dedicate both my professional and personal life to that oath and mission. Yesterday, our community came together in an exercise of democracy and civil discourse that reaffirmed my gratitude to be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Collier County.

While the Bill of Rights Sanctuary ordinance that I supported did not pass on the vote, I believe that most of the sentiments and opinions expressed by both sides of the issue show that we are indeed more united than divided and that we all are concerned about the future of our country and are passionate about our freedoms. The resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners reaffirms that.

I will continue to honor my oath of office, and along with our deputies, will continue to faithfully perform our duties within the framework of the Constitution, as we have always done.”
