1. How long have you lived in Collier County, and where were you living previously?
19.5 years. I was born and raised in North Brunswick, NJ. I attended Arizona State University in Tempe, AZ, and settled in San Diego, CA, before moving to Collier County in 2004.
2. How long have you been a member of the Collier County Republican Executive Committee (CCREC)?
15 years
3. What previous Party positions have you held?
I have been the Precinct Committeewoman in Precinct 317 since 2009. In 2020, I was elected State Committeewoman by 70% to 30% vote. I am running for re-election.
4. Why are you running for this position?
I have enjoyed the job and want to continue to serve in that role. I believe I have made a difference and am the best person for the job.
5. What are the responsibilities of a State Committeeman/woman? Are you committed to fulfilling them?
